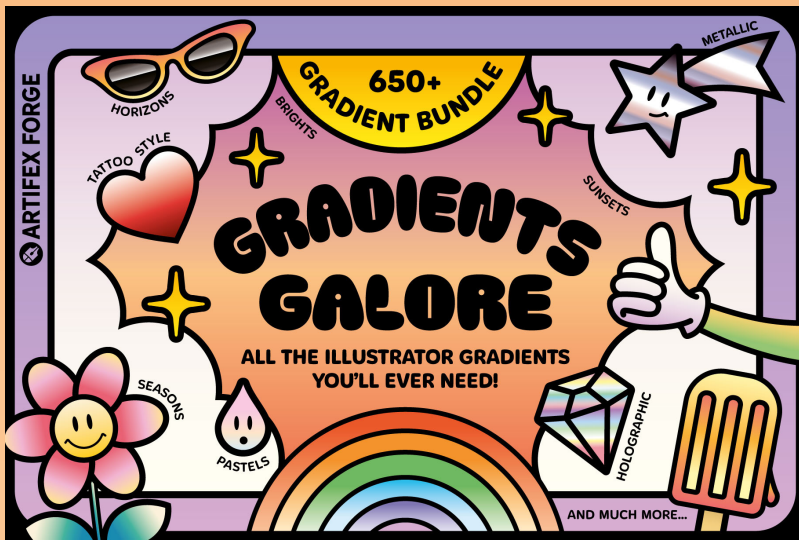

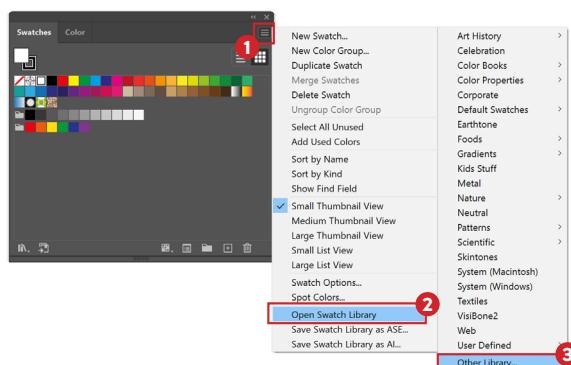

LOADING THE GRADIENTS

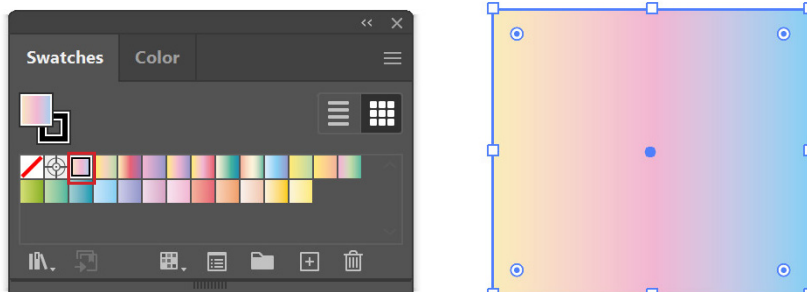
1. Open a document and then open the 'Swatches Tab'.
2. Access the tab's corner menu (1), select 'Open Swatch Library' (2) then 'Other Library' (3) as shown below.



3. Navigate to the un-zipped product folder, select a gradient swatch file and click 'Open'. The newly opened swatch library will open in its own 'Swatches Tab'. Click a swatch or drag it to move it to main 'Swatches Tab'.

APPLY A GRADIENT TO A VECTOR SHAPE OR TYPE

1. With the gradient swatches loaded, select a vector shape/type then click one of the 'Swatch Tab' icons to apply it.

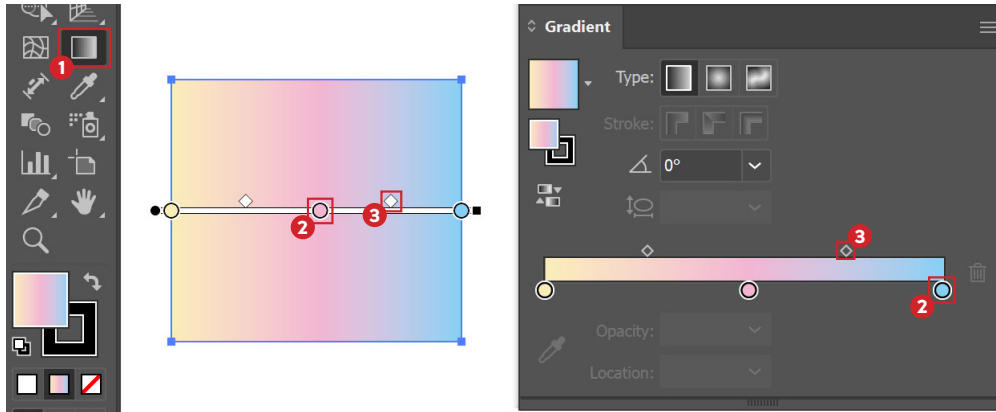

EDITING AN APPLIED GRADIENT

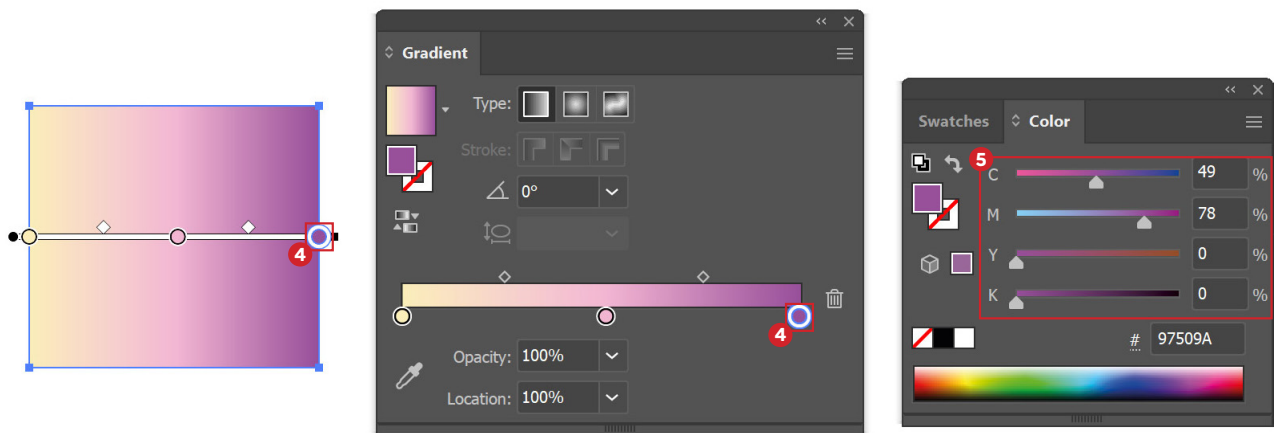
There are two ways to edit applied gradients: By using the 'Gradient Tool' or on the 'Gradient Tab'. Read on to learn how to use these...

Select the object which has the gradient applied to it then select the gradient tool (1).

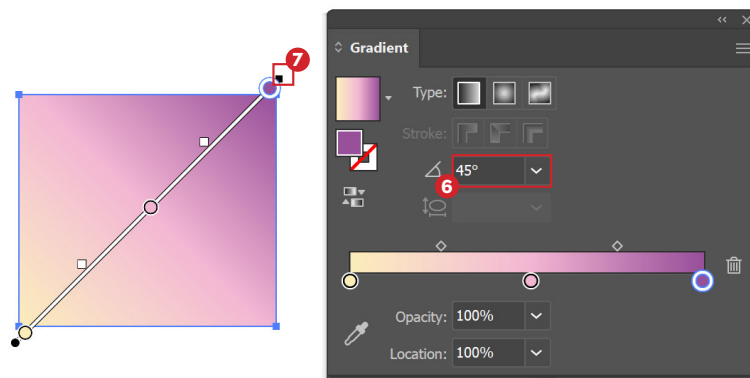


A visual representation of your gradient will appear over your shape and also on the 'Gradient Tab'. The dots (2) represent the colors used in the gradient and the triangles (3) are the mid-points between the colors. Both triangles and circles can be moved to adjust the transitions.

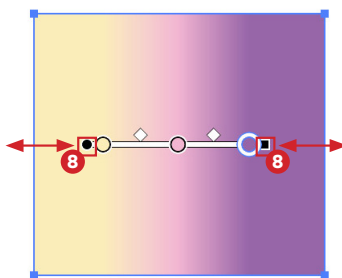
To recolor your gradient, select one of the circles (4) and adjust the color using the 'Color Tab' (5).



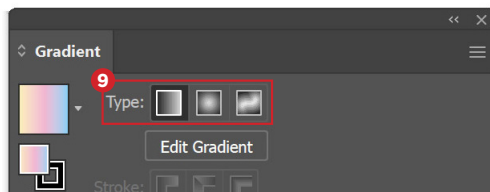
To rotate your gradient within it's shape, enter a number into the 'Angle Box' (6) on the 'Gradient Tab'. Alternatively, hover your cursor to the right of the right-hand circle (7) (on the shape not the tab) until the rotate icon appears and then rotate it.



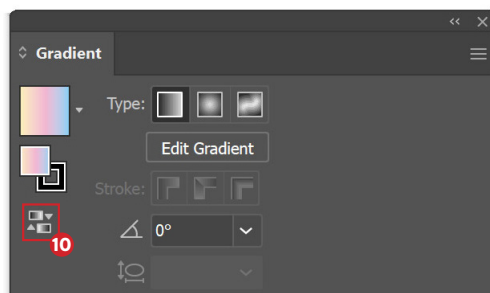
Use the two black end dots (8) to scale or move your gradient.



To change the gradient type click the buttons shown below (9).



To reverse the gradient direction click the button shown below (10).



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
