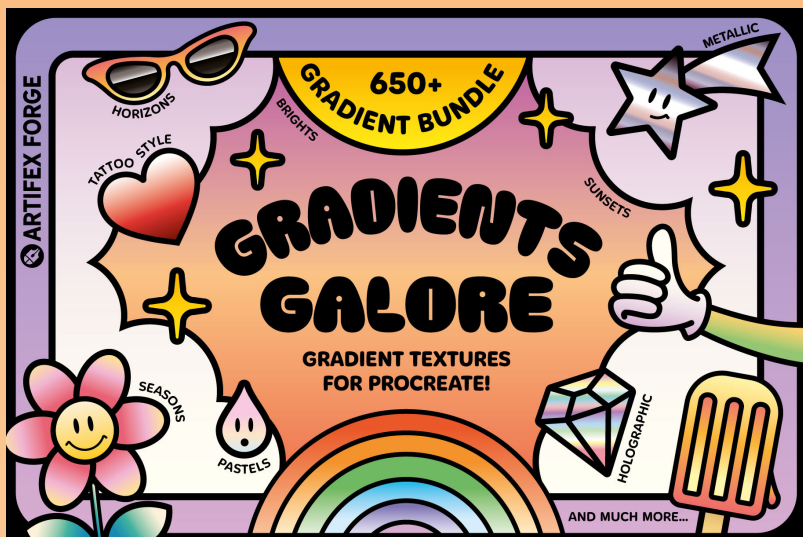

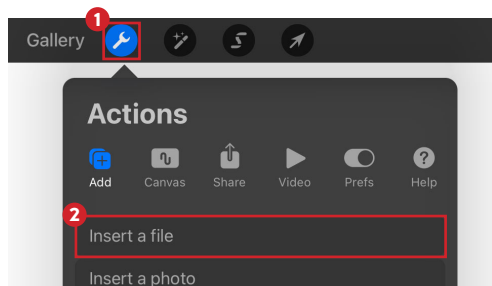

ABOUT THE GRADIENT TEXTURES

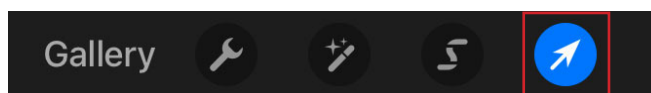
The gradients are supplied as PNG texture files. Add them to your Procreate documents by placing them onto your canvas. After the textures are placed, resize, rotate and edit as per normal graphics. It can also be effective to crop the placed gradients using masks - this can be very useful when creating complex illustrations.

PLACING GRADIENT TEXTURES

1. Download the PNG files to your iPad.
2. Open a Procreate Document.
3. Tap the 'Actions' icon (1) then 'Insert a file' (2).



4. Navigate to where you saved the PNG textures and tap a file icon. The texture will be placed on your canvas.
5. Rotate and scale as desired then tap the arrow icon to confirm the changes.



Once the texture has been added to your canvas you can use it like any other layer. 'Masks' and 'Clipping Masks' are particularly useful when working with textures. Find more out more [HERE](#).

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
